## ~ ABOUT "OUR ARTIST" ~

If the image of grazing horses on the cover of the AHF party notice made you feel a moment's quiet pleasure for things right with the world, then artist Leslie Faust got her message across.

"I've heard so many people tell me the same thing: If your day has been rotten, go to the barn, go to the stables and hang out" she says. "Wouldn't it be wonderful if every troubled soul could have access to horses to help heal them?"

Faust, 56 and a St. Louis native, started her art career in school winning school coloring contests. She won so exclusively that by third grade she had to drop out for anyone else to compete.

The whole family is creative. Her sister Kelly Maue wrote and produced AHF's DVD on laminitis and sits on the organization's board. Her mom Georgia is knitting another Afghan as she has in years past to donate for the auction.

Leslie Faust started earning money from her artwork when she detoured from conventional real estate work to producing renderings of homes and properties for sale. Ten years ago, she "just jumped in" to painting horses professionally and works in all mediums, acrylic to pencil to oils and watercolors. She painted the mural in the lobby of the National Equestrian Center in Lake St. Louis, and she was one of 80 artists whose work was accepted for display at the 2009 exhibit of the American Academy of Equine Art at the Kentucky Horse Park in Lexington.

Faust linked up with AHF after her Arab mare Pattea foundered so severely that Dr. Donald Walsh had to advise euthanizing her. Walsh wrote a moving account of the sadness and release of this "Final Call."

Faust has been a dedicated AHF supporter ever since. For every party, she donates a free painting of a horse and barn as an auction item. And her visual evocations of the horse's peace and joy have become a signature of AHF events.

## HOLIDAY INN AT SIX FLAGS

### A Short History

Who would ever believe that after almost 200 years of serving as a resting place for weary travelers and horses, this 65 acres of land would continue its tradition and become the site of a beautiful resort, complete with guest rooms, an in-house restaurant, meeting and banquet rooms, and an indoor swimming and recreation area.

At the turn of the 19<sup>th</sup> century the Indians who dwelled in this portion of Missouri dug deep springs on the present Holiday Inn at Six Flags acreage to be used in times of drought. Later, as more and more people traveled by stagecoach, the land became known as the “Deep Springs Stageshop,” an oasis for weary travelers seeking their first “good water” outside the city of St. Louis.

In the meantime, St. Louis’ population grew and many impoverished people began to move west. To help ease some of the problems, the county purchased the land and laid it out to build the “St. Louis County Poor Farm.” Irish stone masons were employed to build a large rock building intended for a dormitory. The original structure, a two story L-shaped barn with handcrafted limestone walls up to 36 inches thick, still stands today, and serves as the center of the complex, housing the Hay Market Restaurant, and spacious meeting and convention and banquet facilities.

The construction of the building progressed slowly and then stopped altogether during the Civil War, after financial difficulties occurred. In 1894, an eminent St. Louis veterinarian, Dr. Charles Crowley, bought the land and converted the barn into an up-to-date “horse hospital,” boarding stables, and a horse stock farm which bred many fine race horses. The farm also served as a rest and watering place for cattle and sheep heading East to the National Stockyards in East St. Louis.

After Dr. Crowley’s death in the 1930’s, the land changed hands several times. For one period the barn housed the champion sire, Bar Money. The Deep Springs site was purchased by the Eckelkamp family in 1975 and was developed into the resort facility that you now enjoy, opening in 1981. A complete property renovation took place in 2003.
